Jazz on the Chesapeake Sets Dates for the 2011 Monty Alexander Jazz Festival

The highly successful Monty Alexander Jazz Festival is set for a bigger than ever repeat performance this Labor Day weekend. The Festival is presented by Jazz on the Chesapeake, the recently named program of Chesapeake Chamber Music responsible for CCM's jazz offerings to the community.
